Rules and information regarding Tournament:

- 1) The Tournament is open to all juniors and is not restricted.
- 2) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason.
- 3) Competitors should produce original birth certificate or Registration Card of AITA, if required, to prove Date of Birth.
- 4) A player can take part in not more than two singles events apart from a doubles event.
- 5) It is the players' responsibility to confirm the receipt of their entries before last date and sign in on the date mentioned.
- 6) While the organizers will endeavour to reckon the latest, displayed AITA/TNTA points for main draw and seeding, **it is primarily the player's responsibility to furnish the correct points at the time of registration.** Points mentioned by the players will be reckoned for main draw / ranking purposes.
- 7) Direct Acceptance list for the Main Draw shall be decided based on the entries received on date and in time through web-registration process.
- 8) **Signing in is compulsory on the date and time mentioned. An administrative fee of Rs 100/- per entry will be charged in addition to entry fee of Rs 250/- for those signing-in without registering through website before the deadline.**

- 10) For Doubles event, preference will be given to Main Draw players. Signing in for Doubles events will be announced later.
- 11) All matches will be played at YMCA Triangle Tennis Trust, School of Tennis courts, YMCA College of Physical Education, Nandanam, Chennai - 600 035.
- 12) Court surface (all events): Depending on the entries, the events/matches may be held on any surface (clay or hard).
- 13) Balls: The competitors shall play with the AITA approved tennis balls supplied by the organisers.
- 14) Matches will be decided on knock-out basis as follows:

- 15) Organisers will endeavour to arrange Umpires/Ball Persons for all matches as far as possible.
- 16) Matches will generally be played commencing 6.30 am. Any incomplete match will be played in the immediately following session of play.
- 17) Competitors must be prepared to play more than one match during any or both sessions of the day.
- 18) The Chief Referee may at his discretion, at any time, postpone a match on any account, e.g. darkness, condition of court, weather etc. In case of postponement, the score and previous occupancy of court shall hold good, unless the Referee and players concerned unanimously

- agree otherwise. However, any decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final in this regard.
- 19) It is the responsibility of the competitors to ascertain the timings of their matches. Players must report at the time informed. Matches will, however, be scheduled as soon thereafter as possible depending on court availability. Competitors not reporting on court within 15 minutes from the time the match is first called are liable to have their names scratched.
 - 20) Points for Winners and others will be awarded as per applicable rules.
 - 21) Outstation players will have to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging.
 - 22) AITA rules and regulations and Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.
 - 23) The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters connected with the tournament.
